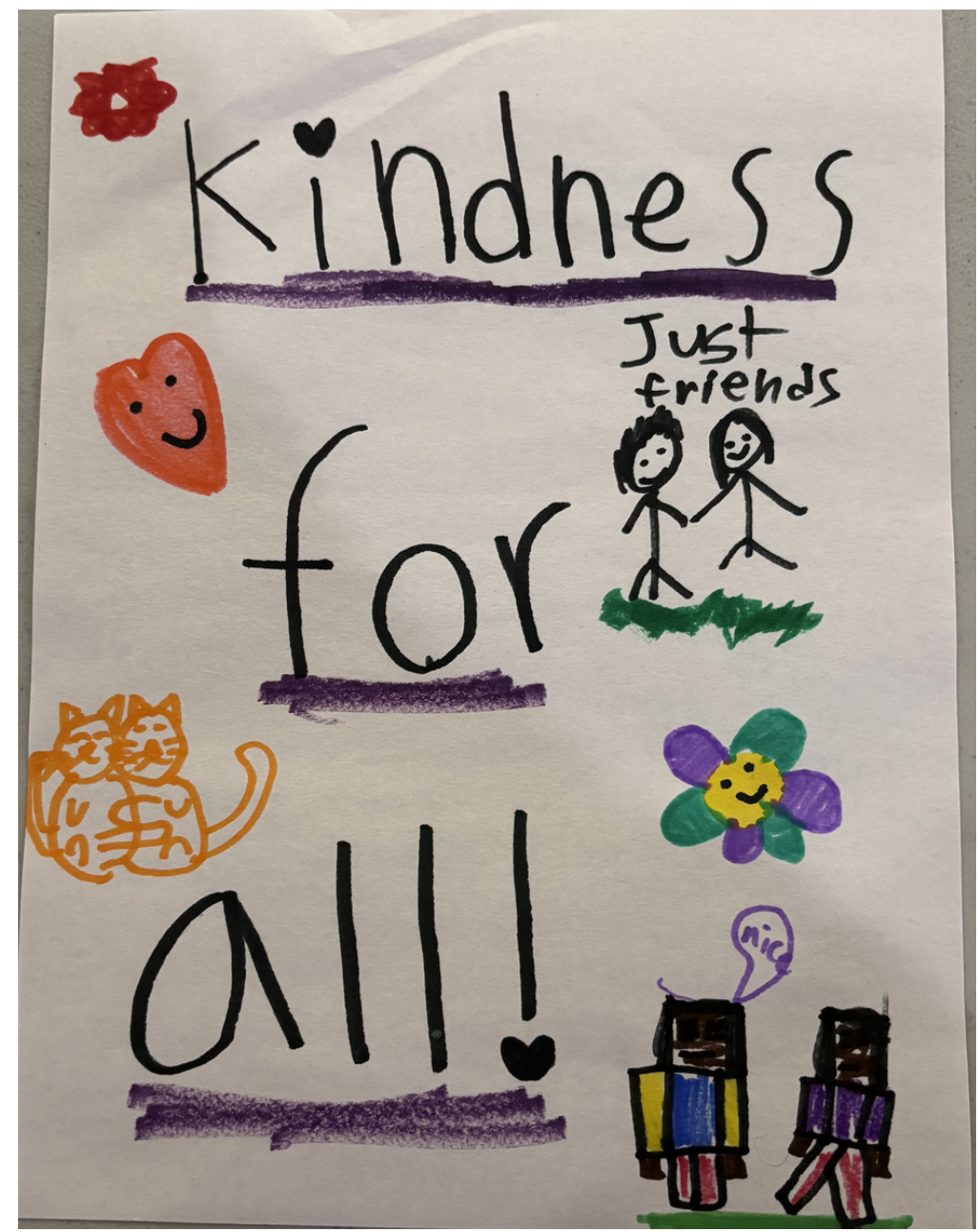


# Presidential Award
